

Aviation Studies - Guidelines for Grading

Students' course grades are approved by the Board of Examiners of HKU SPACE, the decisions of which are final. Students' performance in a course is generally classified into the grades listed below.

Letter Grade	Grade Definition	Grade Descriptors
A	Excellent 優異	Work that demonstrates a superior understanding of the subject matter, being able to develop in-depth solutions to related problems, and with evidence of an extensive knowledge base, original thinking, the capacity to make critical evaluations, and very good organisation and presentation.
B	Very Good 非常良好	Work that demonstrates a good understanding of the subject matter, being able to develop solutions to related problems, and with evidence of critical capacity and accuracy, analytical ability, a reasonable understanding of issues and clear organisation and presentation.
C	Good 良好	Work that demonstrates a sufficient understanding of the subject matter, being able to develop rudimentary solutions to related problems and with evidence of some attempts at analytical thinking, and average presentation and accuracy.
D	Average 一般	Work that demonstrates a basic familiarity with the subject matter, and with evidence of marginal accuracy, acceptable presentation and organisation.
U	Below Average/Unclassified 低於一般水平 / 不予評級	Work showing little evidence of familiarity with the subject matter, with poor accuracy, presentation and/or organisation.

Statement of Results

A notification of results that lists the course and grades a student has attained will be issued by the end of each academic year. No results will be released by telephone or email.

Statement of Achievement

Students who successfully completed the course and attained the results of "Attained", "Attained with Distinction (I)" or "Attained with Distinction (II)" in the HKDSE Examination will be awarded a Statement of Achievement issued by HKU SPACE.
